ISLAND HISTORY & RUM TASTING TOUR

DETAILS:

Your tour begins with a narrated drive around historic Basseterre, one the oldest towns in the Eastern Caribbean. You will view Victorian and Georgian style architecture, important monuments such as the Berkeley Memorial Clock Tower, Independence Square (once a former slave market) with its prominent fountain and impressive centuries-old Catholic Co-Cathedral across the street. Your tour then brings you to the newly restored Fairview Great House & Botanical Garden. Here you will enjoy a guided tour around the Great House, which is believed to have been originally built in 1701 by the French. This Great House has had many owners and inhabitants over the years, each leaving their mark and contributing to the unique history of the property.

The rich history of the site and the island is well displayed with its superbly furnished historical information room that brings to life the 1700s – 1800s with true impressions of what life was like on an Estate in St. Kitts during that era. After touring the Great House discover the stone cobbled courtyard with the old kitchen building housing the original volcanic stone and brick oven, along with the old bathing room housing a large volcanic stone warmed bath. Here in the cobbled stone courtyard, you will be given the opportunity to taste several flavors of Caribbean rum be given the history of where rum came from in the Caribbean, how Caribbean people made their own rum and a short demonstration of rum being distilled. Hear stories of when the Irish settled on St. Kitts and the rum legacies, they left with us and how and where rum drinking has evolved on the island. After your rum tasting experience, take time to wonder in the 2½ acre

After a safety briefing, you will mount your ATV and follow your guide on a thrilling ride through remains of sugarcane fields and down dirt tracks. Ride across country roads and up scenic slopes enjoying panoramic views. Along the way, you may stop to sample local fruits in season. Your ride continues as you traverse the lush mountain greenery of St. Kitts and make a brief stop to enjoy the beautiful views and a refreshing beverage before the transfer back to your ship.

NOTES:

- Minimum age is 16 years and maximum age is 60 years.
- Maximum weight is 250 lbs.
- ATV ride is single rider only.
- Valid driver license required.
- Closed-toe shoes and pants are recommended.

An ideal activity for couples or families, the breath-taking views create a perfect backdrop for those vacation photos. This guided eco-tour takes you on a journey to experience the beauty and splendor of the natural environment. Mount your horse and experience the beauty of nature's splendors on an unforgettable guided ride through the countryside. On your journey, look out for wildlife as well as bamboo, wild coffee, sea grapes, wild cherries, wild sage, mangoes, and pineapple. Plus get a closer look at the national flower of St. Kitts and Nevis, the aptly named Flamboyant. Riding along on the back of your horse, feel the gentle breeze of the trade winds. And be sure to have your camera ready to capture breathtaking views of Basseterre and the tranquil Caribbean Sea. On a clear day, you'll even have views of the neighboring islands.

OFF-ROAD JEEP EXPEDITION & BEACH

DETAILS:

Experience the interior of St. Kitts' mountains. St. Kitts, a volcanic island, is blessed with mountainous slopes that are lush with rainforest and offer majestic views. Your family and friends will enjoy the off-road thrill as you drive your very own iconic Jeep Wrangler. Your tour begins with a short drive to the base where your jeep awaits. After the short orientation, you are off to a fun adventure. Drive to the first off road mountain trail. At the top of the mountain take in a panoramic view of the valley of Basseterre as you view the ship in the background feeling the cool breeze and mesmerized by the natural beauty. Drive back down the mountain and stop at another mountain top which gives you a panoramic view of the St. Peters and the South East Peninsular. Continue the tour on the curved road trails passing the international airport where on some days you can see planes land and take off. After the trip through the interior of St. Kitts, drive to the Vibes Beach Bar which has a perfect blend of an island and sports bar atmosphere, filled with all the amenities you expect at a beach bar. Sun bathe or swim in the calm Caribbean Sea until it is time to return to your ship.

Experience a touch of tropical rainforest and off roading pleasure in the heart of St. Kitts, as well as a refreshing swim in the magical Caribbean Sea.

Board your vehicle at the pier and head inland, traveling through villages and then up into cool mountain rainforests. You travel off road into the interior of St. Kitts in specially modified 4x4 Land Rovers. Venture to a private mountain top property, 1000 feet above sea level, enjoying panoramic views over the island's rainforest and quilted coastline. See a view of the capital city of Basseterre and our sister island, Nevis.

Here you will be served a fresh local fruit juice. Be sure to bring your camera for exquisite photo opportunities. Your journey then continues through the mountains to the opposite side of the island where you will discover quaint villages and the country life of St. Kitts.

Drive along the windswept Atlantic coastline as you head towards the beach for a refreshing swim in the Caribbean Sea. Relax and unwind on the beach or swim off our golden sand beach or just beach comb before returning to port.

TOP 10 BEST OF ST. KITTS

DETAILS:

Discover the beauty of St Kitts on this half island tour. See the lowland valley area which the French once occupied and called Basseterre.

View the historical remains of colonial architectural buildings, historical attractions, the state St. Georges Anglican Church and Co Cathedral Catholic Churches dating back to the 17th Century. Your informative driver guide will not only highlight the areas but entertain you en route. A short stop at the welcoming strategically placed Cenotaph in Fortlands area.

Your next visit is to the Palm Court Gardens. Take a stop at Romney Manor/Caribelle Batik. A must-see UNESCO World Heritage Site is the Brimstone Hill Fortress National Park, an impressive fort perched above the Caribbean Sea. You will be taken to the lookout at Timothy Hill, arguably the most popular photo stop on the island.

Before reaching the popular Frigate Bay Beach, drive past Timothy Beach Hotel and the 'Strip' which comes alive at nights. Return to Basseterre where your ship awaits you via Bird Rock route, a modern residential area for more views of Basseterre's harbor.
