DETAILS:

This unforgettable excursion will have you traveling along the coastlines on the Sir Francis Drakes Highway heading through small villages such as Capoons Bay, Apple Bay, Carrot Bay, and then you will ascend about 900 feet above sea level between the Atlantic Ocean and the Caribbean Sea. Photo stops will be made along the way.

Enjoy stunning views and the different shades of beautiful water. Your knowledgeable driver/guide will keep you a constant company as the history and culture of the island is related via the public address system. At Long Bay beach, enjoy a relaxing swim in the crystal-clear water or just relax to the singing of the waves along the seashore.

NOTE:

Transportation is either by open-air safari bus or air-conditioned bus, depending upon availability. Tortola is a very beautiful island, however there will be many curved roads and going up and down hills. Please note that the beach that this tour includes (Long Bay Beach on Beef Island) is a very pristine and natural beach, and has been specially chosen for its tranquility, and is known to be less crowded. There are restrooms, beach chairs and umbrellas; food concessions are available on the beach for purchase. Guests should wear swimsuits; bring towels and sunblock. Bring cash in small denominations.

VIRGIN GORDA & THE BATHS

Activity Level: Strenuous

DETAILS:

Take an approximately 45-minute cruise along the Sir Francis Drake Channel to Spanish Town, Virgin Gorda. Open safari buses take you on an approximately 15-minute drive through Spanish Town to The Baths for a self-guided tour, where you can swim in the unique atmosphere of mammoth boulders, palms, and sea caves. Travel along the trails and boulders to discover hidden caves and sea pools.

NOTES:

Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. The footpath to The Baths is rough, consists of uneven terrain and goes through small spaces. Footpaths and the rocks may be slippery at times, depending on the weather conditions. Please make yourself aware of the beach flag warning system and adhere to it at all times. Expect crowded locations and high temperatures. Minimum age to participate is 5 years of age. Not recommended for people with any walking difficulties. This is a self-guided tour. Tour escorts will lead the group down the path and stay with guests for the duration of the tour. COVID safety protocols must be always adhered to. Guests who go ashore do so with the understanding that they will be mixing with members of the general public.

TORTOLA JEEP & BEACH

DETAILS:

Drive a Jeep through the island's naturally beautiful terrain and then head off-road to one of Tortola's most secluded beaches. With the guide providing commentary via a two-way radio, you will take in the best of the West End on the way to isolated Smuggler's Cove. Here, you will be free to relax however you please. You might stretch

out on the sheltered beach, stroll along the shore, and take a refreshing swim in the sea.

In time, you will drive off once again into the tropical landscape, where you will pass beach-blessed Long Bay and the surfer's paradise of Apple Bay before arriving in the fishing village on Carrot Bay. While browsing its museum, you will behold an impressive collection of shells, all found on Tortola's many beaches. More spectacular sights await you atop Windy Hill, from the Stoutt's Lookout Bar and at Sky World, an elevated vantage point with 360° views of the British Virgin Islands.

NOTES:

Each jeep accommodates up to 4 passengers. (priced per person) Guests traveling in smaller parties may share the vehicle and driving duties with others. All vehicles are automatic transmission. Guests must be 25 years of age or older and present a valid driver's license in order to drive. Children's car seats are available upon request and subject to availability. Expectant mothers and guests with a history of back and/or neck injuries are not recommended to participate. Bring cash/credit cards if you wish to purchase souvenirs or snacks. Beach chairs, umbrellas & snorkel gear are available for rent. COVID safety protocols must be always adhered to. Guests who go ashore do so with the understanding that they will be mixing with members of the general public.

DISCOVER TORTOLA

DETAILS:

Take in stunning views as you begin your drive through Road Town, the capital of Tortola. The bus will begin its ascent into the hills heading to Belle Vue. As you take in fresh thoughts and take photos from the lookout point at Manchester, enjoy the beautiful scenery as you drive along the Ridge Roads capturing views and adjacent islands including Guana Island nestled in the Atlantic Ocean.

The tour continues on to the village of Cane Garden Bay, home to the famous Cane Garden Bay beach. During this stop you will have free time to visit the shops to purchase your local souvenirs, relax or take a quick swim in the crystal-clear water; after which the tour bus will make its way down the northern shore driving through small villages like Carrot Bay, Capoons Bay and Apple Bay, Zion Hill and down the scenic coastal Sir Francis Drakes Highway back to the ship.

NOTES:

The majority of the transportation used is open-air safari type vehicles. Tortola is a very beautiful island, but with many curved roads and going up and down hill. Bring your camera, sun protection and cash or credit cards for shopping. Wear swimwear under clothing if you desire to have a quick swim at Cane Garden Bay. Bring cash in small denominations.

4X4 EXPLORATION & BEACH

DETAILS:

Enjoy a fun and exciting drive on your off-road safari jeep with wonderful views of Tortola and the surrounding islands from viewpoints that are not the typical tourist route. Your scenic drive around the island takes you through villages, on and off-roads and along coastal roadways.

Departing the cruise port, you will pass through Road Town before following a trail up to Ridge Road. There will be stops at various points for photo opportunities. Next, visit a beach and have a refreshing drink. Rinse the dust off with a swim in the sea or relax on the white-sand beach before continuing back to the ship.

NOTES:

Participants must be at least 5 years of age and weigh no more than 300 lbs. Not suitable for pregnant women over 5 months or guests with bad backs. Must be able to step up two 12-inch steps into the vehicle and able to sit on bed or bucket seats while traveling over rough trails. A restroom stop is made before arriving at the beach, which does not have facilities. Bring a towel, sunscreen, hat, cover-up, and sunglasses.

TORTOLA CANOPY TOUR AND SCENIC

Activity Level: Moderate

DETAILS:

Board your private transportation for a journey through Road Town. Drive along Ridge Road with amazing views over the north coast of the island. After a brief photo stop to view the islands of Guana, Great Camanoe and Anegada, you'll drive westward to the Original Virgin Canopy Tour base camp. After a quick restroom break, the friendly staff will outfit you with your gear. Following a brief orientation and safety talk, you'll arrive at the take-off point of the tour. The tour has been expertly designed for adventurers of all ages (from 5 to 95) and every stop along the way provides you with an amazing "I can't believe I just did that" photo opportunity that you will want to share with friends and loved ones.

The tour including the outfitting and safety talk and the 7 traverse and other challenge components, will take approximately 1 to 1-1/4 hours, depending on group size and other factors. One element of the tour includes a 1-1/2 story climb (21 steps) up an inclined ladder – but don't worry, you are attached all the way. Following the tour, you can enjoy some refreshments or snacks (not included in the price), shop for souvenirs or just relax and take in the wonderful view from the patio before you board the bus. Stops will be made for photo opportunities on your drive back to the cruise ship terminal.

NOTES:

Participants must be at least 5 years of age and weigh no more than 270 lbs. Not recommended for people with vertigo, back or neck problems, walking or balancing problems and pregnant women past their first trimester.
