- At the kennels, you will meet the dogs and climb onto a wheeled sled, custom made for running during the snow-less summer months.
- The husky team will whisk you along a wooded trail through some of southeast Alaska's beautiful temperate rain forest. Spruce and hemlock trees and 12" thick spagma moss surround you on this unique one-mile ride.
- Then, sit down and enjoy a presentation, have refreshments and cuddle with some adorable husky puppies.
- Before heading back, you can wander through the musher's camp with your guide and learn about the equipment, hard work, and great husky strength that go into the life of dog sledding in the wild, rugged North.

In this region of mountains and fjords, weather conditions can vary quickly and dramatically. During much of the hike, the views are panoramic; there are many opportunities for spotting wildlife and taking photographs along the trail, with frequent interpretive stops.
