Rounding out the menu are baby red potatoes, fresh oriental salad, and a scrumptious blueberry cheesecake dessert. The return drive showcases charming Ketchikan and its dramatic mountain, forest, and coastal scenery.

and the animals that call this region home. Enjoy the stunning water views of Totem Bight State Park, home to an Alaska Native clan house and a collection of 14 towering Tlingit and Haida hand-carved, cedar totem poles. Marvel with us at the panoramic, mountainous seascape surrounding Guard Island, while you photograph the first lighthouse to be built in Alaska, completed in 1904 and still in operation today. Sip a hot chocolate and keep on the lookout for harbor seals, moon jellyfish, pigeon guillemots, deer, blue heron, whales, and other wildlife. A complimentary snack of local Alaskan hor d'oeuvres, including our signature smoked salmon dip, will be served while underway.

- Hear the stories about how from remote logging camps up and down the coast of southeast Alaska, you could hear the pounding of the axe, the singing of the crosscut saw, and the cry of "Timber!"
- Learn hardy lumberjacks would gather each summer in the sawmill town of Ketchikan to compete against rival logging camps.
- Discover these fit, rugged men fought hard to take home the bragging rights of becoming the "Bull of the Woods."
- See that today these legends live on at the "Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show."

## DUCK TOUR: A HISTORIC CITY & HARBOR TOUR

### DETAILS

A state-of-the-art amphibian will get your Ketchikan visit off to a "splash", taking you through the rustic streets and into the scenic harbor for a fun filled tour. On this fun filled excursion you will: Depart from the cruise ship dock and experience this unique boat/bus will take you through the historic downtown of Ketchikan, driving past the Deer Mountain Hatchery and City Park. Stop at the Salmon Ladder, Creek Street, and the Totem Heritage Center for photo opportunities (guests do not disembark the vehicle during these stops). Continue through downtown towards Bar Harbor to the Duck's launching ramp for a unique experience. Next take on the water portion of the tour will take you into the Tongass Narrows, past local canneries, seaplanes, fishing boats with an informative narration from the crew of the "Duck". Have the opportunity on the water to spot wildlife, there is always a chance. Make a short stop allowing you to disembark for a photo opportunity before returning to the cruise ship dock.
