Explore the charm of coastal Tasmania in this exciting tour to the breathtaking town of Stanley with many special photo opportunities. As

you travel to Stanley, a charming fishing village crowned by an unusual land formation best known as The Nut, enjoy beautiful coastal views of an area aptly called The Edge of the World.

Explore the local culture of Stanley and take some photographs of the panoramic coastal views before making your way to The Nut, the only remains of an ancient volcanic plug! You will use the chair lift to the top, where you'll have spectacular panoramic views and more photo opportunities.

Enjoy free time for lunch on your own, in one of the many friendly local establishments. Walk the quaint streets and perhaps look at the house where Australia's first Prime Minister was born!

Visit the Historic Highfield House, a homestead built from 1832-35 as the residence of the Company's chief agent, Edward Curr. The setting is perfect, with views across The Nut and Bass Strait. Enjoy a self-guided tour of the house, learning about the historic nature of this homestead.

Continue your scenic drive and stop at Table Cape Lookout. Take plenty of panoramic photos of the area before making your way back to the pier.
