Delight your senses, as you explore the Top-10 best attractions of Roatan. Visit the Freaky Iguana Farm to feed hundreds of different iguanas in their natural habitat. Located near the beautiful beach of Half Moon Bay, the Roatan Chocolate Factory will provide you with a demonstration on the process to make some of the world's best and rarest chocolate. A stop in the West End Village's "The Rusty Fish" offers great insight into life in the area, and tourists from all over the world stop in this gallery to purchase some of the recycled art created here.

At the Roatan Rum Company, guests are able to enjoy the spectacular view of the lighthouse from outside, while enjoying a variety of authentic homemade rums in the building. At the only Cameo Factory in the Americas, enjoy watching master craftsmen create jewelry and art by carving away at shells, conchs, coral, and stone. Drive through Coxen Hole and pass City Hall on the way to a private beach where members of the local Garifuna tribe will share their music, dancing, language, and food. Relax on this beautiful beach, before being brought back to the ship.

BEACH HORSEBACK RIDE & SWIM

DETAILS

Horseback Riding: Take an off-road trail ride into the Caribbean Sea on your beautiful horse. Familiar with the route, these good-natured horses will immediately put you at ease so you can enjoy the nature around you. The ride begins on an off-road trail from which the beautiful blue Caribbean Sea comes into view. When you reach the end of the trail, ride your horse right into the waters of the Caribbean Sea.

Beach Club: Enjoy relaxing on a lounge chair and experience one of the best private Caribbean beaches on the island. A variety of drinks and food are available for purchase.

NOTES

Requirements & Restrictions: Minimum age – 8 years old. Maximum weight – 225 lbs. For safety reasons, pregnant women, and guests with back or neck injuries or heart/respiratory conditions may not participate in this excursion. Closed-toe shoes are required, water shoes available for rent. Helmets are provided and mandatory to wear.

What to Bring: Beach towel, insect repellent and cash or credit/debit card for purchases.

Good to Know: Cameras are not allowed during the activity for safety reasons. Helmet-mounted cameras are allowed.

JUNGLE ATV ADVENTURE & BEACH ESCAPE

DETAILS

ATV Adventure: Enjoy a half-day adventure off the beaten path and into the jungle on a powerful all-terrain vehicle (ATV). Ride the fully automatic ATV along a winding jungle trail, across banana and cashew plantations, climbing to a mountain top for an amazing ocean view. You will receive a safety briefing and gear before setting off with the guide along winding trails through forests and dense vegetation. Follow the expert guide through Blue Harbor Tropical Arboretum, a “Tropical Eden” of 160 eco-friendly acres.

Beach Club: Swim at one of Roatán’s finest beach spots. Relax in a beach chair or grab a kayak and go for a paddle. The water sports, food and beverages can be purchased for an additional cost.

NOTES

Requirements & Restrictions: Minimum age – 16 years and must present a valid driver’s license. Maximum weight – 240 lbs. One person per ATV. Helmets are provided and mandatory to wear. Closed-toe shoes are required. For safety reasons, pregnant women, and guests with back or neck injuries or heart/respiratory conditions may not participate in this excursion.

What to Bring: Beach towel, insect repellent and cash or credit/debit card for purchases. A valid driver’s license for verification. While visiting Roatan, you will be on the Bay Islands National Marine Park, the largest protected marine area in Honduras. 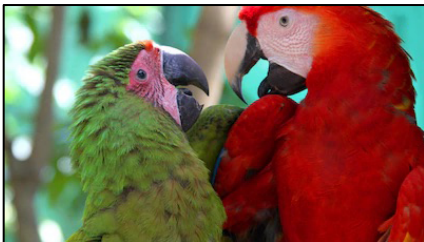
