Joe's Stuarts Conch Stands: Visit Joe's small conch garden and learn about Bahamian, world-famous conch cracking demo.

Requirements & Restrictions: Guests must be able to walk approximately one mile over paved and dirt surfaces and walk up/down a flight of steps on the tram and at the Dolphin House.

What to Bring: Beach towel and cash and credit/debit card for additional purchases.

Good to Know: Tasting of local conch fritters or conch salad is \$3.00 each.

ADVENTURE JEEP, BEACH, & LOCAL LUNCH – AUTOMATIC

DETAILS:

Jeep Tour of West Nassau: Get behind the wheel and start your guided tour from downtown Nassau, the capital and cultural hub of The Bahamas. Drive through the colorful shopping district on Bay Street and see highlights, such as the pink-hued House of Assembly. Head west past the lovely Cable Beach and see the JFK Memorial, which recognizes President JFK's historical trip to The Bahamas in December 1962 where the Nassau Agreement was signed. You will also get a view of the fabulous and sprawling Baha Mar resort that is a famous Bahamian landmark.

Nassau Caves: Quick photo stop at the caves of New Providence, home to the Arawak or Lucayan Indians, who were the original inhabitants of the Bahamas.

Saunders Beach: Spend free time on one of Nassau's most inviting beaches; also, a popular swimming spot for the locals. Relax and take in the quiet stretch of white sand, lined with tropical trees, and sheltered by an offshore island.

Bahamian Lunch: Enjoy a bountiful local lunch at the Bahama Grill, also a favorite restaurant among the locals.

What's Included:

- Bahamian Lunch: BBQ chicken, pork ribs, Bahamian style macaroni and cheese and vegetarian options. Lemonade or water.

NOTES:

Requirements & Restrictions: Minimum age – 5 years. Minimum age to drive – 25 years old with a valid driver's license. Maximum weight limit – 300 lbs per person. Maximum height – 6 ft and 2 in.

What to Bring: Beach towel, cash, or credit/debit card for additional purchases.

Good to Know: Guests will be assigned four per jeep and share driving time. There are three stops on the tour where you will be able to switch drivers. Only automatic jeeps are available. Free time at Saunders Beach is approximately 45 minutes.

TOP 10 BEST OF NASSAU

Sightsee Nassau: Begin your sightseeing tour by bus in historic Rawson Square with highlights including Gregory's Arch, the Roman Catholic Cathedral, Government House and Parliament Building.

Stops include:

Rum Cake Factory: Experience a locally made delicacy at the Bahamas Rum Cake Factory where you can indulge in a variety of samples of rum cakes with flavors including chocolate, banana, pina colada and more.

Atlantis Resort: Drive over Sir Sidney Poitier bridge for breathtaking views of Paradise Island on your way to your stop at the iconic Atlantis Resort, where you'll have time to explore the Marina Village and Atlantis casino.

Queen's Staircase: Commonly known as the 66 Steps, the Queen's staircase was carved out of limestone in 1793 and provided an escape for soldiers at Fort Fincastle when under attack. The attraction has been preserved and is a popular tourist destination for visitors.

Graycliff Heritage Village: Explore the attractions of the historic Graycliff Village. Shop for souvenirs and native artifacts at the museum and Graycliff stores. At Bahama Barrels, the country's first wine distillery, enjoy free samples of local wine. Graycliff is world-renowned for its famous cigars and chocolates. Watch the cigar rolling and taste chocolate samples from the local chocolate factory.

John Watlings Rum Distillery: Be welcomed with a pina colada rum sample before touring the historic estate and learning the process of rum making in Nassau. Next, take time to relax and order a variety of drinks and cocktails on the outdoor patio with cool ocean breezes and views.

Fish Fry and Junkanoo Beach: Drive through the local Fish Fry and stop at Junkanoo Beach for a beautiful photo op on the white sand beaches.

Christ Church Cathedral: Dating back to 1670, the cathedral is the oldest church in The Bahamas where you can view the church's beautiful white, gothic stone, and stained-glass windows with historical plaques from the early historical era in Nassau.

What's Included:

- Food and drink samples throughout the tour.

NOTES:

Accessibility: Tour is ambulatory accessible; you must be able to take a few steps (up/down) and walk short distances. Collapsible wheelchair can be stored.

What to Bring: Camera, credit/debit cards and cash for purchases.

Good to Know: The order of the stops can vary to prevent overcrowding. John Watling's Distillery is closed on Bahamian Holidays. Proof of vaccination is required to drink inside John Watlings. Not required to drink on the outside patio.

DOLPHIN CLOSE ENCOUNTER

DETAILS:

Discover Sanctuary Bay: Sanctuary Bay is a natural 9-acre lagoon and home to 12 Atlantic bottlenose dolphins. Established in 1999, it's been recognized for its focus on education through interaction.

Dolphin Encounter: Learn about these dolphins while they splash and jump around you. Then, step onto a submerged platform where you will pet, kiss, and hug a dolphin. Your dolphin trainer will educate and entertain you with facts about these amazing creatures and tell you more about the facility, where they live and how the dolphins are cared for.

Bird Experience: Explore the bird patio, home to macaws, cockatoos, and African tortoises of all sizes. Animal care staff will be on hand to safely handle the birds while you take some "insta-worthy" photos.

NOTES:

Accessibility: Tour is ambulatory accessible. You must be able to take a few steps (up/down) and walk short distances. Collapsible wheelchair can be stored.

Requirements & Restrictions: A parent or guardian must participate in the dolphin program with children under 16 years old. Cameras and cell phones are not permitted during the dolphin program. For the safety of the dolphins, please remove jewelry and do not wear tanning oils and excessive amounts of sunscreen.

What to Bring: Beach towel and cash for purchases (cards not accepted).

Good to Know: All ages are welcome. The platform depth is approximately 3 ft, and any child unable to stand flat footed on the platform without assistance will need to be held by the parent or guardian. This excursion does not offer an observer option. Professional photos will be available for purchase.

OFF ROAD ATV, TROPICAL GARDEN, AND BEACH BREAK

DETAILS:

ATV Adventure: Start your off-road course with winding trails through the Bahamian bush. Ride through the paved road leading to beautiful sand and sea, where your guide will happily share some island history before completing your ride. This tour is full of excitement and incredible panoramic views of the turquoise sea.

The Garden of the Groves: Stroll through the lovely gardens and do some time retail therapy shopping for authentic Bahamian arts and crafts.

Beach Stop: Taino Beach is one of the most popular beaches on the island. A picturesque stretch of white sand adorned with narrow palm trees that sway with the wind. Spend one hour of free time to relax on your towel or take a dip in the clear blue waters.

What's Included:

- Helmet.

NOTES:

Requirements & Restrictions: Minimum age to drive – 21 years and must present a valid driver's license. Maximum weight – 280 lbs, per person. For safety reasons, pregnant women, and guests with back or neck injuries, heart or respiratory conditions may not participate in this excursion.

What to Bring: Valid driver's license (drivers), beach towel, water, and cash or credit/debit card for purchases.

Good to Know: One person per ATV. All vehicles are automatic. Helmet is provided and mandatory to wear.
