


SHORE EXCURSIONS

January 23 – St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands

CAPTAIN MORGAN VISITOR CENTER & BOTANICAL GARDENS

DETAILS:

You will leave the pier and drive to the wonderful 16 – acre St. George Botanical Gardens through the rainforest (weather permitting). St. George Botanical Gardens grounds were home to a Saladoid Indian Village from 100 to 900 A.D., a Danish Sugar Plantation from 1733 to 1917, a cattle ranch after 1930 and the Botanical Garden from 1972.

You will enjoy a spectacular mix of history and natural beauty with a variety of themed garden areas set among the historic structures of the colonial era sugarcane plantation. The property is listed twice in the National Registry of Historic Sites for both the Amerindian archaeological site and the Danish colonial sugarcane plantation village.

Next embrace another exciting trip, this time into the world of the famous Captain Morgan. The Captain Morgan Visitors Center is a spectacular tourist attraction that immerses every visitor in a legendary experience that captures the Captain's personality and brings his story, the story of rum and the US Virgin Islands together.

- Drink with alcohol or non-alcohol included at Captain Morgan Visitors Center.
- Guests must be 21 years of age to drink alcohol.

HISTORICAL WALKING TOUR OF CHRISTIANED

DETAILS:

St. Croix is a quiet laid-back island generously endowed by Mother Nature and steeped in a rich cultural heritage and Old-World charm.

After a 45-min transfer to Christiansted, guests will be greeted by a tour guide for their walking tour, the best way for the town to be explored. Christiansted's well preserved Danish architecture and graceful shaded archways tie together many points of interest in the town.

Among those overlooking the harbor is Fort Christiansvern, a yellow brick fort built by the Danes to ward off pirates and threats from other countries. Nearby Steeple building is the island's first church which is now a museum. The old Danish Customs House and the stately Government house.

Guests will have 1-hour free time to stroll along the Christiansted boardwalk and take in the sights and sounds of its quaint shops and restaurants and picturesque harbor.

Throughout the tour you will be educated on the culture and heritage of St. Croix and experience panoramic views that provide excellent photo opportunities. After a 1½-hour panoramic drive with photo stops you will reach the beautiful and historical town of Christiansted.

Enjoy one hour of free time to browse around, do some shopping, or visit on the famous Fort Christiansvern on your own.

WEST END HIGHLIGHTS

DETAILS:

Explore the three most popular places in St. Croix. At Estate Whim Museum history comes alive as you walk among the original 18th century buildings of this former sugar estate.

The stately authentically furnished great house welcomes you with gracious guides waiting to tell you stories of past inhabitants and plantation life. Next you will be visiting the wonderful 16 -acre Botanical Gardens.

These grounds were home to an Saladoid Indian Village from 100 to 900 A.D., a Danish Sugar Plantation from 1733 to 1917, a cattle ranch after 1930 and the Botanical Garden from 1972. Your last visit will be the islands oldest distillery where the world-famous Cruzan Rum has been produced for 300 years! Guests will see how the rum voted best in the world is made!

A guide will lead up the ladders to catwalks, where you can look into huge open vats of fragrant, boiling brew. Adults are invited to belly up to the bar and sample the many flavors of Cruzan Rum while kids have a soft drink.

STROLL THROUGH FREDERIKSTED

DETAILS:

Of all three historic towns in the Virgin Islands, the history of Frederiksted is arguably the most remarkable. You will enjoy a walking tour that shares the history of the town while showcasing the magnificent waterfront, historic Fort Frederik, Victorian townhouses, and historic churches.

Tours begin on the waterfront adjacent to the pier and wind their way through the wide avenues of the town, from Strand Street to Customs House Street, then on to Prince Street where the Old Danish School and St. Patrick's Church stand then to King Cross Street and ending at Strand Street Park.

Inside visit of Fort Frederik and Caribbean Museum. Guides will highlight the important architectural and design elements of the historic buildings which reflect the Danish Colonial and African influences of the builders, history of the families who own and occupy the buildings and their historic uses.

The tour ends outside the Mall in the front street.

NOTES:

- Not recommended for guests with walking difficulties.
