Details:

Mayan Ruins: Explore and climb the tallest Maya ruins in the Belize City port and enjoy the best panoramic view of the highlands of Western Belize. As an extra treat, see Guatemala atop the highest structure of El Castillo. After a countryside tour through the western community villages, take a shorthand-cranked ferry ride to the gateway of the ancient Maya ruins of Xunantunich.

Authentic Lunch & Shopping: Enjoy local shopping and a tasty and hearty traditional Belizean lunch in a nearby local town before heading back to the port.

What's Included:

- Traditional Belizean lunch.
- Archeological park fees.

Notes:

Requirements & Restrictions: For safety reasons, pregnant women and guests with neck, hip or knee injuries and seizure, heart or respiratory conditions may not participate on this excursion.

What to Bring: Bug repellent, a poncho (in the event that it rains), and cash or credit/debit? Card for? Purchases.

Good to Know: Travel time from the pier to Xunantunich is approximately two hours. Climbing may not be allowed on rainy days.

What better way to discover the natural beauty of the Belizean jungle than on horseback?

On this excursion you will:

- Take a 40-minute motor coach ride through Belize City to Bacab Eco Adventure Park and listen as our guide imparts to you a bit of our very colorful Belizean history.
- Secure your belongings then head over to the horse mounting area to receive a safety briefing, riding instructions and be paired with a horse that matches your riding skills.
- Climb onto our mounting mounds, designed especially to make mounting/dismounting our horses "a walk in the park", and mount your waiting steed.
- Follow your guide and embark on your journey to explore the exotic tropical forest on horseback.
- approximately one hour of exploring, you'll return to the pool area to enjoy a delicious Belizean lunch at the "Pokonobwai Restaurant and Bar".
- After lunch, relax at poolside in a hammock under the shade or enjoy the waterfall and slide at our free form pool. Your kids will enjoy our mushroom water feature in the kiddie's section.

Throughout your stay, you can enjoy various presentations and activities that showcase our Belizean history and culture and/or learn about our natural healing remedies by visiting "Ixchel Medicinal Trail" before returning to the port.

Get ready to be the captain of your own private mini speedboat navigating through Faber's and Almond Hill Lagoon enjoying the scenic view of the Belize waterway. This tour provides the excitement and thrills of navigating a 13ft power boat in comfort and style. Excellent for first time boaters, you will get to follow your lead captain through a

historic and pristine waterway. Look out for a variety of bird species and the occasional manatee and crocodiles. This fun filled family tour will allow you to cruise as slow or as fast as you like. The mini speedboats are safe, easy to use and filled with loads of fun. Each mini speedboat features an engine that is environmentally friendly.

Notes:

The minimum age to attend this tour is 8 years old.

- The maximum weight is 250 lbs. per person.
- If there is an odd amount of people in your group, you will be paired up to fill the mini boat.
- The minimum age to drive is 17 years old and all drivers must present a valid driver's license to drive.

Details:

Your excursion will begin at the pier at Fort Street Tourism Village, where you'll board your 4x4 UAZ (SUVs built to traverse mountain terrain). Each UAZ carries four guests, one of whom will be the appointed driver. On your way to the Altun Ha Mayan ruins, you will have a chance to admire the beautiful Belizean countryside. Altun Ha was once a thriving Mayan city. Artifacts of these 2000-year-old ruins were uncovered in the area by workers searching for stone to use to build the Old Northern Highway. These ancient ruins include 13 structures surrounding two plazas, and a 60-foot Temple of the Masonry Altars, an important ceremonial site for the ancient Mayan civilization. Once you reach Altun Ha, you will get a chance to climb to the top of the Temple for a breathtaking panoramic view of the two plazas. Lastly before returning to the pier, you will be served a traditional Belizean box lunch with rice, beans, and chicken.

Notes:

- The minimum age to participate is 7 years old.
- The minimum age to drive is 17 years old with a valid driver's license.
- The maximum age is 65 years old.
- Pregnant woman and guests with heart conditions, or neck or back injuries are not permitted.
- UAZs are 4-seater vehicles; four guests per vehicle.
- All vehicles have manual transmissions.

On this exciting off-road expedition, you'll board a bus to the former orange plantation of Balam Ha. This magical place was believed to be sacred because of its location next to the source of a river that borders the estate. Once there, you will have the chance to hop aboard a Can-Am UTV and drive through the breathtaking tropical forest. Led by expert regional tour guides, our Balam Ha Can-Am UTV Tour gives you the chance to glimpse the natural wonders of Belize like never before. You'll climb into your UTV and venture through an exclusive property, with the freedom to traverse off-road, steep terrain. Once you are done with the UTV trail, you can hike through the forest to a hidden oasis and dive into refreshing blue water. Get in touch with Mother Nature and explore the magic of a Mayan purification. Afterwards, enjoy a meal of juicy BBQ that will be setup right beside the river and exclusively for you.

Details:

Step aboard the charming Calypso Train and explore Belize City by open-air trolley train. See the Baron Bliss Lighthouse, named after the man, buried in a tomb near its base. You'll witness stark contrasts, from affluent residential districts to the workingclass neighborhoods. Continue downtown where you'll pass St. John's Cathedral, Central America's first Anglican church, originally built in 1812. St. John's Cathedral is also known as one of Belize's oldest surviving buildings. Then cross over the iconic Swing Bridge, the only manually operated bridge of its kind in the world. Your return route takes you pass Memorial Park, which honors the fallen soldiers of World War I, in route to the Tourism Village pier side where you can enjoy free time shopping for local handcrafts and souvenirs.

Details:

Mayan Ruins: Altun Ha Archeological site is one of the Maya sites located nearest to the port. The ancient Mayan city is made up of two plazas and 13 structures, which includes the Temple of the Sun God where the jade head of the Maya sun god "Kinich Ahua" was found. The jade head is one of Belize's national treasures.

Altun Ha Museum: The Altun Ha Museum on site provides a wealth of information on Maya lifestyle, temple architecture, rituals, and pottery.

Scenic Drive: Enjoy a scenic drive through part of the city and countryside while your guide speaks on Belizean culture and history.

Lunch: Enjoy a delicious Belizean lunch at a local restaurant.

What's Included:

- Local Belizean lunch.
- Bottled water.
- Altun Ha Museum.
- Shopping time at Artesian Village.

Notes:

Accessibility: Tour is ambulatory accessible; you must be able to take a few steps (up/down) and walk short distances. Collapsible wheelchair can be stored.

Requirements & Restrictions: Wheelchair can access location. Closed-toe shoes required. For safety reasons, pregnant women, and guests with back or neck injuries, respiratory illness, high blood pressure or heart conditions may not participate on this excursion.

What to Bring: Cash or credit/debit card for purchases.

Good to Know: Ruins are approximately 60 minutes away from ship. Guests are not allowed take video footage or use drones at Maya site and cannot climb ruins before or after rain for safety reasons.



Helmet Dive at Rendezvous Caye with Lunch & Drinks \$104.99 / Person Belize Activity Level: Moderate Meal Included Duration: 4 Hours

Details:

Enjoy the sensation of walking on the ocean floor while you keep your face and hair dry and breathe comfortably without the use of a regulator or mouthpiece. Your adventure begins with a trip to Rendezvous Caye, a private island located just over the main barrier reef of the Western Hemisphere. After a safety briefing and familiarization practice, you will admire the colorful marine life and see up close one of the best barrier reefs in Belize. Stroll at depths of 15 feet whilst breathing normally, wearing nothing more than a bathing suit and a helmet, and discover the undersea world. After your great underwater experience, gear down and enjoy some beach time on the private island of Rendezvous Caye, where you can relax and swim. An authentic Belizean Lunch and Rum Punch are included to make your day even better.

Notes:

- The minimum age to attend this tour is 12 years old; the maximum weight is 250 lbs.
- Pregnant women and guests with cardiac conditions, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy or under certain medical
- restrictions are not permitted on this excursion.
