Discover the magic of "Cocina Criolla" by spicing up your day during this exciting historical walk and gastronomical experience. Learn about the historical facts of ancient old San Juan and taste the rich flavors of Puerto Rican cuisine. Start your journey by taking a brief walk while familiarizing yourself with important historical details of Puerto Rican culture. Your guide will walk you through important historical sites like Museums, the San Juan Gate, the Princess Pathway and Prison to name a few. After you have discovered the mysteries that the cobblestone streets, you will also visit the fabulous shopping district where you will be able to purchase anything from Puerto Rican coffee to unique pieces of art. Become a chef for the day by learning how to prepare a Puerto Rican native dish: Mofongo. You'll be taught how to create this one-of-a-kind dish and a Mojito cocktail by getting hands on experience from a Chef.

HISTORY BEHIND THE WALLS – WALKING TOUR

DETAILS:

Have a knowledgeable tour guide take you back in time through the ancient city of Old San Juan. Visit Castillo San Cristobal, the largest fortification built by the Spanish in the New World. Explore and walk through its underground tunnels and gain additional insight of unique military strategies at a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Walking distance you will arrive to see the impressive San Juan Capitol Building, El Capitolio, designed in a marble Neoclassical Revival style that hosts the House of Representatives and Senate of the Island. Plaza San Juan Bautista sits right across the street, see the colorful glass mosaics of the major townships and cities displayed. Arrive to The Walkway of the Presidents, where nine bronze life size statues of all the Presidents who have visited Puerto Rico while in office are standing. Alongside, see memorials like the Puerto Rico Police Memorial Monument & the San Juan Holocaust Memorial. This walkway also includes Plaza de la Mujer, a Plaza in honor of important Puerto Rican Women. Walking the Constitution Avenue, learn the history of buildings like Casa de España and The Antiguo Casino of Puerto Rico, which are among Puerto Rico's most beautiful and oldest buildings, these structure boasts from the scenery with unique architectural features that reminisce the glory and splendor of the early 20th century. Travel through time at South Fortaleza Street and learn the history behind the famous and historic Tapia Theater and the Arturo Somuano Plaza. Your historical journey ends at the famous Christopher Columbus Plaza, surrounded by restaurants, cafes, and souvenir shops you can choose to visit at leisure just before heading back to the ship. Enjoy some free time at the shopping district down San Francisco Street or enjoy being escorted back to your ship.

RUM, MIXOLOGY & SALSA CLASS

DETAILS:

On a short Old San Juan walk get a feel for the city and be delighted by your enthusiastic bartender/tour guide who will narrate how during historical times like the Spanish American War in 1898, the famous rum & Cola – Cuba Libre was created. Enjoy the views of this colorful ancient city. Get to know the cocktail star of Puerto Rico, the delicious Piña Colada! Learn how this world-famous rum cocktail was invented here and try the original recipe. As you arrive to the Rum Scene, begin your mixology class by creating an exciting Caribbean rum cocktail and learn how to garnish it. With your shaker or mortar get ready to make and enjoy a delicious Mojito or a historical Daiquiri. Smell and savor hints of spices, strong molasses, and caramel overtones of aged rum, flavored or crystal. Discuss and learn where each of these Puerto Rican rums are made, their differences and how to mix them. Enjoy some tasty Pinchos - Puerto Rican chicken or pork skewer with your drinks, and finally have your Salsa dancing instructor show you the stylish dancing moves of the culture. At the end of your tour, celebrate your day in San Juan with a shot of Puerto Rican Licorice rum, yummy!
