Experience a fantastic adventure created for those that love the outdoors. This excursion offers a bike ride through the jungle, a dip into a Mayan Cenote "water hole", the chance to try standup paddle boarding and beach time with lunch. You'll depart from the pier aboard the Jaguar truck a custom-designed vehicle outfitted with all the equipment needed to make your experience an amazing one.

Enjoy a 15-minute scenic drive to your first stop where you'll mount a tandem bicycle and ride through the jungle. Arrive at the Mayan Cenote "water hole" and cool off in the water. Hop on the Jaguar truck and travel to your next destination a beautiful white sand beach where your guides will set up a camp for you. Here you can try standup paddle boarding, enjoy a boogie board ride, take a swim, or just relax on the beach. A lunch will be offered at the beach before heading back to your ship after a fun-filled day of adventure.

Participants must be at least 8 years of age, a maximum 65 and weigh no more than 320 lbs.

Experience the Mayan Reality on a cultural adventure that will both educate and delight you. Many visitors think of the Mayans as an ancient civilization that disappeared long ago, but the fact is that while many other indigenous groups have vanished or been absorbed into the general population, the Mayan culture, customs, language, and beliefs remain strong on the Yucatan Peninsula, even today. On this tour you'll witness the reality that faces these remarkable people as their ancient culture collides with and blends into the modern world. Begin your adventure in a small, contemporary Mayan community built up around the remains of an

ancient Mayan settlement and visit one of the fascinating ruins located right in the middle of town.

Follow your guide into an authentic Mayan house where you'll learn about the local food and the ancient medicines. You'll hear about the sacred Mayan tree and its role in the cosmos as well as legends, lore and prophecies written in the Mayan calendar. If you've visited any Mayan ruin or are remotely interested in the first people that populated the Americas, then you'll be surprised, fascinated, and left with a new-found respect for this long-lived culture and the legacy they leave here in Costa Maya.

Chacchoben Mayan Ruins

DETAILS

You'll journey to the ancient place of Mayan pilgrimage known today as Chacchoben, also known as "The Place of Red Corn". At the pier, you'll be greeted by a bilingual guide who will direct you to an air-conditioned bus. Onboard the bus your guide will brief you on the interesting history and unique attributes of this sacred Mayan site. Upon arrival at Chacchoben you'll be surrounded by jungle. Your guide will escort you through the ruins, giving you a complete explanation of the sacred temples and other structures seen there.

See original red paint on the stucco walls of one of the pyramids and the temple where a mural was found showing the astronomical positions of the planet Venus. You'll have time to climb the Gran Basamento taking you above tree level. Here archaeologists found ceremonial offerings dating to around 1000 B.C. Your guide will also explain about the wildlife and medicinal plants that are used by the modern-day descendants of the ancient Mayan people.

NOTES

- Transfer time to the ruins is approximately one hour.
- Tour includes 2 bottles of water.
- There is a government tax of \$5-8 US for the use of video cameras at the site.
- No tripods and/or professional video cameras are allowed.
- Guests with recent surgeries, heart or respiratory conditions, pregnant women and those with walking difficulties are not allowed to participate.
- We recommend that you bring insect repellent.
- Guests who go ashore do so with the understanding that they will be mixing with members of the public.

HARVEST CAYE, BELIZE

Mayan Ruins & Spice Farm

DETAILS

Discover the ancient Mayan archeological site of Nim Li Punit along with its treasures and visit the Belize Spice Farm and Botanical Gardens to see how they cultivate and harvest exotic spices.

Board your air-conditioned bus for a scenic ride to the archeological site of Nim Li Punit, "Large Hat" in the Mayan Kekchi language. The site was so named due to a depiction on a Maya stela of one of its rulers wearing a very large headdress. This unique Mayan ceremonial site has a small museum and a welcome center where you can see some of the large stelas with well-preserved Maya drawings and writing, as well as artifacts. It also has a ball-court in the center of the complex and an observatory in one of the plazas. The entire site is shaded by a canopy of large trees, providing a comfortable environment for viewing this very interesting Mayan site.

Head over to the Belize Spice Farm and Botanical Gardens and see how vanilla, nutmeg, maze cardamom, cinnamon, cloves, and black pepper are cultivated. As you travel through the farm via tram, you'll see how these unique spices are dried and processed for packaging. Afterward, relax in the comfortable guest center where you will have the opportunity to purchase some of the spices that are grown here.

NOTES

- This tour may operate in reverse from time to time.
- Participants must weigh a maximum of 275 lbs.
- There are approximately 100 steps to negotiate.
- Good general health, no preexisting heart conditions, pregnant women past first trimester, must be able to walk up and down stone stairs unassisted and step in and out of farm tram.
- The minimum allowable age to participate in this tour is 5 years old.
- Credit cards and cash can be used to purchase handicrafts and spice products.
- Your tour will include an approximate 30-minute boat transfer to the Belize mainland and the transfer to Nim Li Punit is approximately 1 hour from the tour starting point.

DETAILS

Depart from the Malacate Pier on your air-conditioned bus for a scenic one-hour bus ride to the picturesque archaeological site of Nim Li Punit, or "Large Hat". Nim Li Punit is in the Mayan Kekchi language. This is the name given to this site, due to a depiction on a stela of one of its rulers wearing a very large headdress. This unique Mayan ceremonial site was built on a hillside overlooking the fertile Toledo lowlands where crops were grown to feed the Mayan rulers that occupied this temple. Here at this well-maintained site, there is a small museum and welcoming center where you can observe some of the large stelas and artifacts that have been preserved. Nim Li Punit, also boasts a well-preserved ball-court in the center of the complex, and a Mayan observatory is also located within one of the various plazas. This entire site is canopied over with large trees, providing a shady comfortable environment for viewing this interesting and beautiful archaeological site.

After your tour, you will head to Spice Farm for a warm welcome, a delicious and traditional Belizean lunch. Here you will be able to purchase various local drinks and souvenirs. It's now time to head back to your ship docked at Harvest Caye, it's been an interesting, fun, and educational adventure, one filled with Mayan history and an excellent overview of Belize's natural wonders.

- Participants must weigh less than 300 lbs.
- There are approximately 100 steps to negotiate.
- This tour is not recommended for guests who are pregnant and past their first trimester.
- The minimum allowable age to participate in this tour is 5 years old.
- Bring comfortable clothing, walking shoes, a cap or hat, and sunscreen.

You will then visit the area's only extreme adventure park to stroll a nature trail through the jungle canopy, much of it along suspension bridges. From this vantage point high above the jungle floor, you can expect to see colorful flowers clinging to vine-draped trees, chirping tropical birds flitting through the air, and creatures such as iguanas and lizards perched on the branches. In this extraordinarily peaceful setting, the sounds of the jungle will be all the more captivating.

Continuing to a beachfront resort in the heart of West Bay Beach, you will enjoy more free time to savor the island ambiance. A brief but immensely scenic boat ride will take you through the protected mangroves lining the waterways that flow into French Harbour, which lies just up the coast from Coxen Hole. The setting will seem like a world away from the relative bustle of the town, which serves as Roatan's commercial hub. At a nearby resort, you will delve into the local Garifuna culture by watching folkloric dances that have changed little over the centuries. The traditional Garifuna language, dance, and music are so unusual that UNESCO

added them to its Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity list. Tastings of Garifuna-made cassava bread and chocolate will enhance your understanding of their unique Afro-Caribbean lifestyle. It will be an eye-opening experience that you can reflect on while relaxing on the resort's magnificent beach.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Cruise through the protected mangroves near French Harbour, Roatan's commercial hub.
- Watch the local Garifuna perform folkloric dances that depict their unusual history.
- Sample traditional cassava bread and chocolate that the Garifuna made by hand.
- Relax however you please at the beach along one of French Harbour's loveliest resorts.

Your tour begins as you board your bus for a ride through the beautiful landscape of Roatan Island. See the locals at their daily activities in Coxen Hole, the commercial district of the island. Visit the best arts and crafts store of Roatan Plaza Mar -the store is handicapped accessible. Stop at one of the oldest Methodist churches on Roatan for a photo opportunity, where your guide will share the local island history with you.

Drive up the top of "El Mirador", the highest point of Coxen Hole Harbor and enjoy a great view of the island's beautiful coastline. At the Rum Cake Factory, you'll sample the sweet cakes and then enjoy a refreshment at the Gio's Restaurant. From there, your drive takes you through the hills of Roatan to the West End to admire the architecture and beautiful homes of Sandy Bay.

- Guests must be able to walk 30 steps to the Rum Cake Factory or remain inside the vehicle.

DETAILS

Come experience the world famous, magnificent ruins of the walled city of Tulum, the only Mayan city built right on the blue Caribbean Sea! After a 45-minute ferry to Playa del Carmen, your guide will lead you to an air-conditioned motor coach for a scenic and informative one-hour drive to Tulum.

Once there, your guide will escort you through the ruins giving a complete narration along the way. See the restored temples and some of the mysterious hieroglyphic writings still visible today. Visit the temple of the frescos, famous for the detailed carved figures and original paints. And perched on the edge of the Caribbean and rising high above all of the other ruins is “El Castillo” with its breathtaking view of the aqua-colored water below.

NOTES

- There is approximately 1 mile of walking over rocky, uneven terrain.
- Ferry ride across may be rough at times and guests who suffer from motion sickness should take this into account.
- Guests who go ashore do so with the understanding that they will be mixing with members of the general public.
- Grounds at the ruins consist of uneven limestone and loose stones, and extra caution should be taken, so as not to slip and fall.
- There is a government tax of USD8-USD10 for the use of videography in all areas of the ruins, this includes taking videos with video cameras, tablets, or mobile phones.
- Tripods or professional video equipment are not permitted.
- The use of face masks is mandatory.
- A responsibility waiver has to be signed prior to participation.

Visit key points of the city such as the Church of the Cross. It was built in 2018 to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the first mass celebrated on the island – and in Mexico.

Stretch the legs and explore the shops by the main square. Find goods from all over, from cheerful crafts to sophisticated brand clothing, jewelry, and perfumes.

Don't miss the opportunity to take some selfies by the colorful Cozumel add or the gigantic Mexican flag before it is time to go back to the ship after a memorable outing.

Taco & Tequila Pairing

Savor a pairing of tacos and tequilas that highlights Mexico's traditional food and spirit. UNESCO added Mexican cuisine to its list of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity because it involves so many ritual practices, techniques, and ancestral customs. The taste is even more impressive as you will discover by sampling three distinctly different types of tacos. Tacos Dorados are unique in that the corn tortillas are stuffed with spiced meat and then fried until crispy. Cochinita Pibil tacos originated on the Yucatan peninsula and feature juicy smoked pork topped with onions and achiote sauce. You will also likely sample Tacos de Guisado – the so-called King of Tacos – which are made with savory stewed ingredients ranging from steak to vegetables. The tacos will be thoughtfully paired with tequilas that complement their flavors. Silver tequila is usually among the choices as this clear, unaged, or slightly aged spirit is known for its smooth, warm finish.

- Taste three different tequilas that demonstrate the spirit's versatility.
- Appreciate how the thoughtful pairing of tacos and tequila brings out their flavors.
